



Baptisms: Congratulations on the decision to baptize your child in the Catholic Faith! We are here to help you with the process. Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.


