

NEXT WEEKEND: January 6 & 7 is the Feast of the Epiphany

An ancient tradition has parishioners bringing home packets of blessed chalk, using the chalk to inscribe the initials of the legendary Three Kings over the doorway and invoking their protection of the home. If you wish, a small donation made in their honor can be left in the basket containing the packets, as you take one packet per family.

Packets of chalk will be on the steps of the sanctuary and can be picked up at the end of each Mass. Inscribe the following characters above your door.

20+C+M+B+24

The first and last set of numbers refers to the current year. The letters stand for the Three Magi: Caspar, Melchior & Balthasar.
They also represent the three-word Latin blessing: Christus Mansionem Benedicat, which means, "May Christ bless this house."
